





Digital Product Passport (DPP)


a digital identity card that contains detailed information about a product, enabling traceability and transparency throughout its supply chain.







Information included in the DPP

Information to be included in the DPP will be **product-group specific** and identified in delegated act process and may include **information/data** on one or more of the following areas:



Technical performance



Environmental sustainability performance



Circularity aspects



Legal compliance



Product related information





Leveraging DPP for Reporting Obligations



DPP data can be re-used for other reporting obligations by companies, for example *Corporate Sustainability Reporting*, which requires reporting on environmental metrics.

If the goals are set at product level, the reporting can be automated based on the data available in the DPP.

This future streamlining of reporting will also facilitate the work of surveillance authorities.



Upcoming milestones



The public consultation for the Delegated act setting out the requirements for Digital Product Passport Service Providers will be launched soon.



Launch of the **DPP registry** in **July 2026**



Certain types of big batteries are the first product category for which the DPP becomes mandatory in February 2027.



The DPP is being introduced for a wide range of other products, such as toys, construction materials, detergents and textiles, to become mandatory from the end of 2027 onwards.


